Dear Families,

Welcome back to Plunkett Street Public School for term 2, 2018. I trust that you have all had a wonderful time with your families over the school holidays. I know you will join me in welcoming three new families to our school, the Crarer family, the Gordon family and the Barbour family.

The students have settled straight back into classroom routines and the learning programs are up and running.

As we launch into our new three year school plan, we are focusing on improving literacy and numeracy outcomes for all students. One program that supports literacy is the Sydney Theatre Company's In-school Drama Program, which begins this term for the students in years 1-6. This program uses drama strategies to enhance literacy comprehension. The students in kindergarten are continuing with the L3 (Learning, Language and Literacy) program which provides explicit instruction in reading and writing strategies in small daily literacy sessions. All students P-6 will participate in lessons using the Seven Steps To Writing Success Program. With all of this going on, we are sure to see impressive student growth.

Other programs continuing in term 2 are tennis on Tuesday, Sydney Story Factory and Macquarie Bank reading buddies on Wednesday, music and Scripture on Thursday and Mandarin and PSSA sport on Friday.

Please join us for our term Launch Assembly on Friday 11th May at 9:30am. Each teacher will be presenting their class program to the school community.
